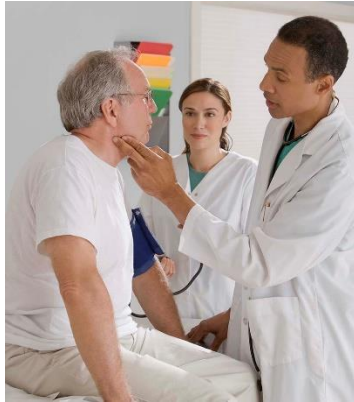


If you experience a hospitalization, it is important to follow up with your MPCP provider to ensure quality and continuity of care.
